

General Rules and Regulations

18.40 SMALL POWER RATE

AVAILABILITY

Available to commercial consumers, small industrial consumers, and three-phase farm consumers for all uses including lighting, appliances, cooking, heating, and motors, all subject to the established rules and regulations of the Association covering this service.

Service under this schedule is limited to consumers whose load requirements are less than 50 kVA of transformer capacity. Consumers having their homes on the same premises with their business establishments may include service to both on the same meter, in which case all service will be billed under this schedule, using the rate set out below. If the consumer prefers, he/she may make provisions for two meters, in which case the usage for residential purposes will be billed under the appropriate residential schedule, and the usage for business purposes will be billed under this schedule and rate.

Single-phase and three-phase where available, at available voltages.

MINIMUM MONTHLY CHARGE

The minimum monthly charge under the above rate will be \$20.00 where 5 kVA or less of transformer capacity is required. For any consumer requiring more than 5 kVA of transformer capacity, the minimum monthly charge will be increased at the rate of \$1.50 for each additional kVA or fraction thereof required. Where the minimum charge is increased in accordance with the terms of this section, additional energy will be included in accordance with the foregoing rate.

18.40 SMALL POWER RATE

CONDITIONS OF SERVICE

1. The rated capacity of single-phase motors will not be in excess of ten horsepower (10 hp) unless written approval is received from the Cooperative.
2. Normally, motors having a rated capacity in excess of ten horsepower (10 hp) must be three-phase.
3. Service under this schedule is limited to consumers whose load requirements can be met by transformers having a capacity not to exceed 50 kVA. Consumers requiring more than 50 kVA will be served under an appropriate schedule for large power service.
4. In those cases where it is necessary to extend or reinforce distribution lines, service will be furnished only under the following conditions:

The consumer will give satisfactory assurance supported by a written agreement as to the character, amount and duration of the business offered.

The guaranteed annual revenue will be based on kVA of transformer capacity as hereinabove provided.

TERMS OF PAYMENT

The above rates are net, due and payable on or before the date stated on the bill. If not paid on or before this date, a late charge of 2% per month and service will be discontinued after due notice.

TAXES, FEES, ETC.

Any tax, franchise fee, or other similar charge, however denominated, will be recovered by a surcharge only upon those consumers receiving service within the boundaries of the district and/or municipality imposing such tax or fee.
