

### General Rules and Regulations

#### 18.62 LARGE POWER – LOAD MANAGEMENT RATE

---

##### **AVAILABILITY**

Available to all consumers of the Association whose load requirements meet or exceed 25 kVA.

##### **MONTHLY RATE**

Grid Access per month . . . . .	\$ 27.75
Member Demand Charge per month per kVA . . . . .	\$ 11.05
MVEA Demand Charge per month per kVA . . . . .	\$ 11.05
kWh Charges per month per kWh . . . . .	\$ 0.03730

##### **DETERMINATION OF BILLING DEMANDS**

The billing demands (as indicated or recorded by a demand meter) will be:

1. for the Member Demand Charge: the maximum 15 minute integrated kVA demand established by the consumer during the billing period.
2. for the MVEA Demand Charge: the maximum 15 minute integrated kVA demand measured at the time of Mountain View Electric Association, Inc's system monthly coincident peak.

##### **BILLING PERIODS FOR DETERMINATION OF MVEA COINCIDENT PEAK**

Daily Summer Hours: (April through September) Beginning the ½ hour period ending 7:30 a.m. to the end of the ½ hour period ending 10:00 p.m.

Daily Winter Hours: (October through March) Beginning the ½ hour period ending 6:00 a.m. to the end of the ½ hour period ending 12:00 p.m. (Noon); and

Beginning the ½ hour period ending 5:00 p.m. to the end of the ½ hour period ending 10:30 p.m.

##### **MINIMUM MONTHLY BILLING CHARGE**

The minimum monthly billing will be the greatest of the following charges as determined for the consumer in question:

1. The minimum charge specified in the contract for service;
2. A charge of \$1.50 per kVA of installed transformer capacity.
3. A charge of \$75.00.

#### **TYPE OF SERVICE**

Single-phase and three-phase, 60 hertz, at available voltages.

#### **CONDITIONS OF SERVICE**

1. The rated capacity of single phase motors will not be in excess of ten horsepower (10 hp) unless written approval is received from the Association.
2. All wiring, pole lines, and other electrical equipment beyond the metering point will be considered the distribution system of the consumer and will be furnished and maintained by the consumer.
3. The consumer will comply with and be bound by the Association's lawful rules, regulations and Bylaws as the same may be amended from time to time.
4. The installed costs of additional equipment necessary for data collection and load management will be paid by the consumer, either as an initial full payment or equal installments up to eighteen (18) months, including interest. These costs will be non-refundable.

#### **TERMINATION CONDITIONS**

Upon termination, this rate will not be available to the same consumer for a period of twelve (12) months.

#### **TERMS OF PAYMENT**

The above rates are net, due and payable on or before the date stated on the bill. If not paid on or before this date, a late charge of 2% per month will apply; and service will be discontinued after due notice.

#### **TAXES, FEES, ETC.**

Any tax, franchise fee, or other similar charge, however denominated, will be recovered by a surcharge only upon those consumers receiving service within the boundaries of the district and/or municipality imposing such tax or fee.
