

General Rules and Regulations

19.70 SECURITY LIGHTING

APPLICABILITY

Applicable for security lighting service for all consumers in towns, suburban, and rural areas served by the Association.

AVAILABILITY

Available to all consumers that sign a one-year contract for an unmetered photoelectric controlled HID (High Intensity Discharge) fixture(s), at standard available voltage.

RATES

Each HID fixture rated at 175 watts, per month	\$ 10.11	I
Each HID fixture rated at 400 watts, per month	\$ 18.17	I
Each additional span of secondary not to exceed 150 feet, per month	\$ 3.77	I
Each additional transformer, per month	\$ 3.77	I

EXTENSION, MAINTENANCE AND RELOCATION

The Association, at its sole discretion and in accordance with sound engineering practices, will erect, build and maintain, under normal wear and tear, the fixtures, poles, wiring and lamps used to render service under this rate.

Consumers requesting security lighting to be mounted on poles other than wood approved by Mountain View Electric Association Inc. (MVEA) or requesting underground security lighting distribution systems will be required to pay the Association, as a non-refundable contribution, an amount equal to the difference between the estimated cost of the requested system and that of the standard wood pole and overhead construction. In any event, all facilities will be installed, owned, operated and maintained by the Association.

The Association will not be required to replace or repair broken lamps or fixtures when such breakage is due to excessive willful or negligent acts other than the Associations'.

The expense of moving or relocating the fixtures after initial installations will be borne by the consumer.

NOTIFICATION OF MALFUNCTIONS

It is the responsibility of the consumers to notify the Association of burned out lamps or any improper operation of the fixture. Repairs will be scheduled during regular working hours of the Association as set forth in the Rules and Regulations.

TERMS OF PAYMENT

The above rates are net, due and payable on or before the date stated on the bill. If not paid on or before this date, a late charge of 2% per month, or fraction thereof, will apply; and service will be discontinued after due notice.

TAXES, FEES, ETC.

Any tax, franchise fee, or other similar charge, however denominated, will be recovered by a surcharge only upon those consumers receiving service within the boundaries of the district and/or municipality imposing such tax or fee.
